During this half term we will be continuing to focus on routines and procedures and encouraging friendly relationships and behaviour by playing lots of circle and ring games. We will be helping children to negotiate and solve problems without aggression, e.g. when someone has taken their toy.

Literacy

Our key texts this half term are 'Room on the Broom' by Julia Donaldson and 'Goldilocks and the three Bears.' Our key rhymes are 'Twinkle twinkle,' 'Incy Wincy' and 'Humpty Dumpty.'

Understanding of the world

We will be helping your child to comment and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.

Expressive Arts & Design

We will be exploring the sounds of musical instruments and how they can be changed. Tapping out simple repeated rhythms and moving in response to music.

Physical Development

This half term we are focusing on gross motor development. We will be going into the hall or MUGGA to develop an awareness of space, coordination and movement.

Communication & language

We will be engaging in lots of activities within provision to develop your child's confidence in communicating. Each week there will also be two talk time groups focusing on developing speaking and listening skills. E.g. using 'and' and 'because' to extend sentences, give explanations as well organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events.

Numeracy

We will be engaging in lots of number songs to help children recite number names in sequence and develop counting skills. We will be encouraging number recognition and positional language.
