

Literacy

In Literacy we will have daily phonics lessons where we will continue to learn new sounds to help us become confident and happy readers! The children will also be able to apply their phonic knowledge in their writing by hearing and saying the sounds that they know to help write words and captions. In addition to this, we will focus on letter formation, spelling common everyday words, using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops and also writing lists, labels and captions linking to our topic of Marvellous Me.

Fabulous Finish

Every topic ends with a fabulous finish which you are invited to attend. This term we will be acting out the story of 'Handa's Surprise' and singing songs about healthy foods.



Mathematics



In maths, we will be learning to count to and across 100 from any given number. We will be learning to read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. When given a number, identify one more and one less. We will be learning to add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20. We will also be learning to recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.

Habits


Each term we will be focusing on one of our habits. We will be introducing it this term by looking at 'Who am I?' and learning about being the best version of ourselves.

History

In history we will be looking at changes within our own living memory. We will also be looking at the journey from reception into year one and changes that have happened within our own lives.

Art and Design Technology

This term the children will be designing and making their own healthy salad. They will learn the skill of chopping, slicing, mixing and preparing foods as well as weighing out ingredients and understanding the importance of hygiene and safety.

Science

In science we will be looking at the human body and how we can ensure we live the healthiest lifestyle possible. We will also notice that animals including humans have offspring which grow into adults and investigate and describe the basic needs of animals including humans for survival.

In PE we will be focusing on throwing and catching through the use of bean bags and balls and playing games such as Hot Potato. In gymnastics we will introduce traveling and coordination and link this knowledge to animal and human movements.
