## Numeracy

We will be engaging in various problem-solving scenarios within provision. E.g. solving problems linked to shells such as sorting, ordering, matching a numeral to a quantity & making comparisons. We will explore real life problems in the shop role-play areas such as finding totals and subtraction. Through the story of the 'Rainbow Fish', we will develop the concept of sharing.

## Communication & language

We will be helping children to understand and use a variety of questions and give clear explanations. During discussions, we will be encouraging children to listen carefully to what others have said in order to continue the main theme and link statements.

## Physical Development

This term we will be developing children's gross motor skills. We will be experimenting with different ways of moving, learning to run in and out of obstacles and developing ball skills.
