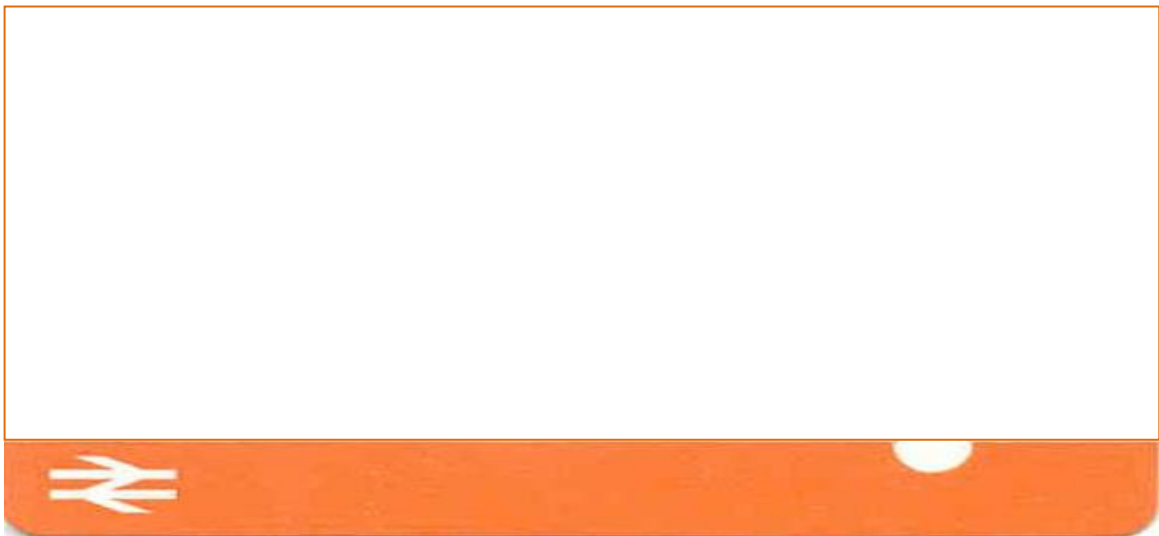


Home Learning - Train Ride

This week in Nursery our learning is focusing around the book 'The Train Ride', we will have a train station in Nursery and will be building trains to take us on journeys. We have attached a train ticket; your child might like to write a train ticket, thinking about where they are going, what time the train sets off and how much the ticket will cost. We have been practising using our pinchy parrot pencil grip and giving meaning to the marks we make. We will also be focusing on using everyday language and words linked to time and money (e.g. pence, pounds, minutes, hours, o'clock).
