

Weekly learning update.....




In RCH Herries, we have had such a wonderful week. In English, we have explored the story The Storybook Knight. We really enjoyed learning about knights and particularly what made Leo brave. 
Weekly learning update.....

In Year 2 Raisen this week, we have started our new English topic, based on the story, Grandad's Island. The children have shown a lot of interest in this story and have started to create their own effective sentences to start to write their own story. In art, we have started using different medias to create some collages. Well done Y2 on a fantastic start to the week.

In Year 2 Symons we have started a new Art topic, and we are learning to create a collage. We used the tearing technique to cut the tissue paper into smaller pieces and then we sorted the pieces according to their colours. We then secured the pieces into place to create a picture.



In Year 3 Emerson we have begun to look at our new book 'Leon and the Place Between'. We spent a lesson studying the author Angela McCallister and have moved onto looking at the setting of the book.



In year 3 this week, Musgrave have been exploring maps of the UK. We have used grid references to locate Cities and physical features such as rivers and islands. We also explored the locations of countries around the world!



In Year 4AP we have started a new looking at tessellation and the work of M. C. Escher who created interesting patterns using repeated shapes.




