
You Said......

The Nursery children have loved going on a bear hunt... we have travelled across obstacle courses retelling the story of travelling through thick oozy mud and swishy swoshy grass. We have made story maps using different marks to retell the story.


In Y2MN Raisen this week we have concentrated on our collage skills in our art lesson. We have used different materials in different shapes to help create wonderful images. In math, we have been looking into the value of what coins are worth. Making pounds, and different amounts of money. Well done year 2!



In Y2YS Symons we have been super scientists. We have been learning all about the properties of materials. We now know that some materials are transparent, some are smooth, some are flexible, and some are shiny too. We sorted the objects according to their properties in the venn diagram.




In 3KH Emerson we have started our new Maths topic on length and perimeter. We have been using a ruler to measure in cm and mm.
