"Run, run, as fast as you can, you can't catch me, I'm the Gingerbread Man". The Nursery children have had a wonderful week exploring the story of the Gingerbread Man, we decorated our very own gingerbread people.



In RJH Crowder we are loving our new learning about dinosaurs. We are looking at different features of dinosaurs including what they looked like, how they moved and what they ate. As a class we are going to choose a type of dinosaur to write a fact file about.



In RCH Herries, we have really enjoyed learning about dinosaurs. We are looking at dinosaurs for the next three weeks. This week we have looked at the Tyrannosaurus Rex, Stegosaurus, Pterodactyl and Ichthyosaurs. We then created a fact file recalling our knowledge on dinosaurs.



In Y1OR Barrie this week we really enjoyed getting stuck into featured author day. Luckily for us, we know the Julia Donaldson texts very well! We took our time to read and listen to a number of stories throughout the day and ended with drawing The Gruffalo.! Well done everyone!



In Y1CF Piper this week we have had a big focus on using number lines to compare numbers to 20 during our math lessons. We have been fabulous using vocabulary such as greater than and less than when comparing numbers. The children have been amazing at using our learning walls to help them with their learning. Well done Y1!






Weekly learning update.....

This week in Y2 Raisen we have started our new math topic on multiplication and division. We have to started to recognise equal groups of a given amount and will now start to link this to how we can begin to multiply and divide, using sharing methods. We will also look at our 3-, 5- and 10-times table.




This week in Y2 Symons we have been doing amazing with our Geography learning. We have been learning to read maps. We have identified different places in our school and our school grounds and made our own maps with a map key too! Well done Year 2!



This week in year 3 Musgrave we have explored the bronze age using a range of sources. We have examined aspects of life such as shelter and food production. We have compared this to our research on the stone age.

In Year 4TB, we are reading the book 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' by Kate DiCamillo. We have followed the china rabbit's anxious journey and written our own chapters.


In 5SW this week, we have completed our collages and have added another medium to our collage by using oil pastels to add an animals features. The final pieces looked really effective. Well done everybody!
