

## **Uniform policy:**

### **Expectations**

We expect all children to wear school uniform every day. School logo uniform can be bought at the school office. Our uniform is a school polo shirt, jumper or cardigan and black or grey trousers or a black or grey skirt. Children could also wear a grey pinafore dress or blue gingham checked dress with black or grey leggings, tights or trousers. Plain black shoes or trainers should also be worn.

We take pride in each and every one of our pupils at the academy and know that they are equally proud to be wearing their Academy badge on their uniforms. We hold regular sales for uniform to purchase them at a reduced rate.



Our academy works with several Schoolwear providers please enquire at reception . Uniform is available to buy online and pay for delivery to your home or pick up directly from the company directly.

You can also purchase plain navy-coloured cardigans or jumpers from high street shops and supermarkets.

Children should not wear jewellery in school.

Children should not wear false nails, nail extensions or false eyelashes.

Children should not wear make up.

All school footwear should be plain black

Children can bring a book bag to school each day with their reading diary and reading books. This can also be bought from the office.

Children need a suitable PE kit for in or outdoor PE and a PE bag. This should include jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts, a t shirt, a jumper and trainers or black pumps. A school logo PE kit is also available to buy at the school office.

## **Rewards**

A daily check sheet is completed by staff in the classroom. The class with the best uniform all week wins the Uniform Police award for the following week.

## **Consequences of non-compliance**

1. Informal discussion with child and family – class teacher
2. Leaflet and reminder given to child/ family – Senior Leader
3. Parent meeting arranged with Senior Leader to set out expectations and identify any barriers to following school policy. This should be logged on Cpoms under Uniform expectation discussion.
4. 1 week monitoring period to see if this improves – Senior Leader
5. Information passed to Principal – formal parent meeting arranged to clarify expectations
